Earlier this week, Governor Green made an announcement with Airbnb.org:

Governor Green and Airbnb.org announce housing support for Maui

If you host through Airbnb.org's program, Airbnb will provide <u>AirCover</u>, which includes \$1 million USD in liability insurance, \$3 million USD in damage protection, and more.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Sign up <u>here</u>.
- 2. You don't have to be an Airbnb Host anyone with space to share can sign up to host exclusively through Airbnb.org.
- 3. Airbnb.org's nonprofit partners on the ground verify guests' eligibility. Their partners include Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Maui Economic Opportunity, Global Empowerment Mission (GEM) and Operation Blessing.

Here is some more inform about about Airbnb.org's program:

- Airbnb.org Hosts offer short-term stays for free
- Existing Airbnb Hosts can offer a discount or offer their place for free
- Airbnb.org guests don't pay anything. Stays are covered by donations to Airbnb.org.
- Airbnb provides Hosts with AirCover, which includes \$1 million USD in liability insurance, \$3 million USD in damage protection, and more.
- You can offer a private room or an entire place

- Airbnb waives Host and guest service fees on all Airbnb.org stays for survivors and first responders
- <u>Airbnb.org</u> is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to facilitating emergency stays for people impacted by humanitarian crises around the world.
